Fall Ball Rules 2024

AAA & AA divisions:

- 1. All players must sit out one inning before a player can sit out a second inning (barring injury).
- 2. Teams will bat their entire roster of players consecutively throughout the game. Player(s) arriving late must be placed at the end of the batting order.
- 3. The half-inning is over once a team has batted through the lineup once, gotten 3 outs, or 5 players have crossed home plate.
- 4. Two (2) adult base coaches are allowed, but only if there is one adult in the dugout while on offense. A team may have a total of three (3) adults (Manager + up to 2 coaches).
- 5. No new inning shall start after one hour and fifty minutes (1:50) from the start of the game. The game stops at two hours and 5 minutes (2:05) (drop dead).
- 6. Pitch Count A maximum of fifty (50) pitches (finishing the batter is allowed) or two (2) innings may be thrown by a pitcher in one game. In this rule "two (2) innings" is interpreted as 6 outs. The pitcher may record 6 outs over two complete innings or in one full inning and two partial innings (the pitcher appears in 3 innings). (If an inning ends due to the 5-run rule the remaining outs that have not been recorded will count as outs toward their 6-out total). Note that if 50 pitches or age limit pitch count is reached before 6 outs are recorded by the pitcher the pitch count limit takes precedence and the pitcher must come out.
- 7. The visiting team is responsible for pitch count, the Home team is responsible for keeping score.
- 8. Players may be borrowed from other teams as long as the player is registered with the league and within the same division. A borrowed player must bat last in the order and play an outfield position. Managers should contact the player agent or Board Member on Duty to coordinate pool players.
- 9. Rule 6.02(c) will not be enforced. (Foot in the box option)
- 10. Rule 9.01(d) will not be enforced. (stealing signs)
- 11. Games may be started with eight (8) players; if the opposing team allows for a player to be borrowed to play in an outfield position.

AA:

1. No dropped third strike.

Machine Pitch only:

- 1. Players will get 5 pitches from the pitching machine, if they foul off the last pitch, they will get another swing.
- 2. No new inning shall start after one hour and thirty minutes (1:30) from the start of the game. The game stops at 1 hour and 45 minutes (drop dead). T-ball: Teams will switch sides after batting through the order. The Catcher's position will not be utilized. The game stops at 1 hour 15 minutes (drop dead). There will be NO GENTLEMEN'S AGREEMENT to modify ANY rules.
